Dictionary definition of *mercy*: Compassion or forgiveness shown toward someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm.

Greek word for mercy: eleemones

From Strong's Greek concordance: merciful, compassionate.

From the Greek word, *eleeo*: compassionate, concern for the misfortune or suffering of others.
