





"What is true of individuals is also true of churches. A church that has become only a venue for adoration of the Divine (proclaiming, "Lord, Lord") has not fully become a part of the realm of God.



A church that has become only a social service agency, even if openly stating that its own motivation comes from Christ, is also not really inside "the kingdom of heaven."



A church that is, at least provisionally, demonstrating the reality of the reign of God in the world will be a gathering of people who seek to deepen their relationship with Christ and who, transformed by that relationship, engage others both within the church and beyond it in the world in ways that make real God's just will for all.".
